

GOAT Competition

Zambia

1. These are the rules applicable to the GOAT Competition (“**Competition**”) as presented by MultiChoice Zambia Limited and its affiliates, partners, co-promoters, sponsors, directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives (“**MultiChoice**”). - 3.1. reside within 30 (thirty) kilometers of Lusaka, Livingstone or Kasama in Zambia; and
- 3.2. participate in the spin-the-wheel game as set out below.

Spin-the-wheel

4. In order to participate in the Competition and stand a chance of winning a live goat (livestock) (“**Prize**”) Eligible Participants will be required to:

- 4.1. play the spin-the-wheel game using the following link:

- 4.2. you can spin-the-wheel up to 3 (three) times per day;
- 4.3. the objective is to collect the most tokens and the most variety of tokens; and
- 4.4. the Eligible Participant who has collected the most tokens and most variety of tokens at the end of the Competition Period will be selected as the winner of the Prize.

The Prize winners will be notified via phone call and will be required to take delivery of the Prize at a premises that is within a 30km radius from either Lusaka, Livingstone or Kasama on an agreed date which must be within 10 (ten) days, failing which the Prize will be awarded to the runner-up.
